

UKRAINIAN DIASPORA RESPONSE

The Ukrainian diaspora has been at the forefront of responding to humanitarian needs of the population in Ukraine since the escalation of the conflict in February 2022. DEMAC has conducted data collection from February 2022 to April 2023 to capture the impact of the response. This involved surveys with 10 Ukrainian diaspora organizations and the use of publicly available sources. The figures mentioned below are estimates because of differing data collection techniques of the assessed sources, and do not represent the entire global response of the Ukrainian diaspora.
